Students who graduated from South Florida Healthcare Institute's Nursing Assistant (CNA), Phlebotomy Technician (CPT), or Medical Assistant (CCMA) programs, are eligible to receive \$500 off their Practical Nursing tuition.

Health & Other Requirements:

- Physical exam – Annual
- Tuberculin (PPD) or Chest X-ray – Annual
- Drug Testing – (Complio)
- Level 2 Background Check
- Compliance Tracking Subscription (Complio- approx. \$132)

Immunizations:

- MMR Vaccine Series (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) (X2) or Titer
- Hepatitis B Vaccine Series (X3) or Titer or Authorized Declination Form
- Varicella Vaccine (X2) or Titer

Uniforms: All students are required to purchase their uniforms through our approved school vendor. Uniforms must be obtained before the start of clinical training. For details on ordering, please contact our Program Director, who will guide you through the purchasing process.

- All White Leather Shoes – closed front and back
- SFHI LPN Uniform Jacket
- White Socks (above ankle) or White Hose

Industry Certification & State Credential Exams:

Students will be prepared to take the NCLEX-PN licensure examination upon successful completion of the Practical Nursing program. Exam costs are additional, and at the expense of the student.

College Credit Transfer: Upon completion of the program and meeting eligibility requirements, students may articulate into an LPN to RN program at another school that offers that program, with advanced standing.

Books / Supplies: SFHI does include the Nursing Kit as part of the tuition. Students will receive a link with instructions on where to purchase the required books and uniforms. The Nursing Kit, which includes a blood pressure cuff, stethoscope, and other items needed for clinicals and the program, will be provided prior to the start of clinicals.
